same.
- 4<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Esquire Hutchings  
the same an equal part of my estate with the other  
children including the \$ 300. he has heretofore  
received as shown per receipt for the same.
- 5<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my grand children, (the  
children of Susan Hardwick my daughter one  
child's part of my estate, including the \$ 195  
she and her husband Wesley Hardwick has heretofore  
received as shown per receipt for the same, With this  
proviso. It is my will that when my estate is



settled that the Court appoint a guardian to have the care of the same and to pay equally to each of the said children of Susan Hardwick respectively their quotas of my legacy when they shall come of lawful age but it is my will that the same be never placed in the hands of the said Wesley Hardwick nor any of his near connection for said purposes

6 I give and bequeath to my son Dalphon Hutchings, an equal share of my estate with the other children including the \$ 205. he has heretofore received as shown per receipt for the same

7 I give and bequeath to my son Joshua F. Hutchings, an equal share of my estate with the other children including the \$ 213. he has heretofore received as shown per receipt for the same

8<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Richard Hutchings an equal share of my estate with the other children including the \$ 213. he has already received as shown per receipt for the same

9<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Joseph A. Hutchings an equal share of my estate with the other children including the \$ 209. he has heretofore received as shown per receipt for the same

10. I give and bequeath to my daughter Margaret Burge's an equal part of my estate with my other children including the \$ 190. she has heretofore received as shown per receipt for the same

11 I give and bequeath to my son William M. Hutchings an equal share of my estate with the other children including the \$ 213. he has heretofore received as shown per receipt for the same



12<sup>th</sup>. I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucinda A. Hutchings an equal share of my estate with the other children and to include two beds and bedding and other articles of <sup>my</sup> personal property selected by my Executors to the amount of seventy dollars

13. I give and bequeath to my grandson William Francis Garrit, son of my daughter Martha B. Garrit (if living) one fourth part as much of my estate as each of my own children shall receive severally and if he dies without an heir said sum of legacy to return equally among my own children

14. It is my will that all my personal property <sup>not herein before bequeathed</sup> be sold by my executors as soon as they may think practicable after my decease and on such credit as they may judge best for the interest of my estate, and that my lands be sold at any time after the lapse of one year from the time of my decease by my Executors on such terms and conditions as they may judge best for the safety and interest of my estate

And that after all my estate is finally settled that the legacies to my beloved wife and all my heirs herein named be equally distributed and paid off in manner hereofers directed

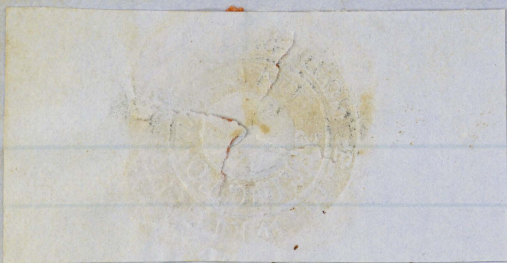


