The first Religious Services were conducted by circuit riding preachers, who came to this area several times a month. In 1806 a Methodist Meeting House was erected in Carlisle.

The Beginning of the Town of Sullivan

By 1820, the population of Sullivan County had reached 3,498. By 1852, Sullivan had been named

the County Seat. In 1853 Sullivan was incorporated.

The Coming of the Iron Horse

With the establishment of industrial venture there came the necessity for getting new manufactured products to market, and therefore the pioneers became interested in a railroad.

Storm Clouds Threaten

Event followed event. The Southern States seceded from the Union one by one. The election of Lincoln to the Presidency brought to a head the long smouldering feud between the States.

Aftermath of War

Dark clouds of strife fell over the nation and Sullivan paid her share of lives to the cause of Freedom.

Learnin' The A, B, C's

As the area started to increase in population, education became a subject of great consideration to the people of Sullivan County. From the crude surrounding of a simple beginning to the fine system of schools today, Sullivan has rapidly progressed in it's march toward a higher education of learning.

Bikes, Bustles and Mustaches

It was the era of the "Bicycle Built for Two", "Leg O'Mutton Sleeves", "Empress Eugenie Hats", and the wasp like waists. The innovation called the horseless carriage made its first appearance and caused quite a sensation. All good fun of the Gay 90's reminiscent of the days when Grandma was in her teens.

World War One

The year was 1914 and again the people heard the troubling sounds of war in the making. The climax came in 1917 when the Lusitania was sunk and the United States entered the war.

It was the age of "Yes We Have No Bananas", Plus Fours, and the Flappers. A dance sensation hit the nation and everyone in Sullivan was doing the Charleston.

The Sullivan Hall of Fame

Sullivan men and women who have made their mark in the community and in national affairs.

Lest We Forget

With startling suddenness on the quiet afternoon of December 7, 1951, the news of war came to the United States for the second time in a generation. The Battle of the Bulge and the South Pacific were just a few of the places in which Sullivan boys fought, struggled and died.

Young America

Again in this half-war, half-peace atmosphere. America turns to her youth—the Spiritual descendents of those who were the Spirit of '76, the pioneer of Sullivan youth, upon whom the destiny of America depends. Upon these young Americans will rest the responsibility for the integrity and the continuing growth of the nation.
